Please ensure you submit all the relevant original documents that you want the Entry Clearance Officer to see when considering your application. The list below is for guidance only. It is not a list of documents that you should or must supply. The UK Immigration Rules make it clear that it is your responsibility to satisfy the Entry Clearance Officer that you are genuinely seeking entry to the UK for the purpose and duration that you have stated. Submission of particular documents does not guarantee that your visa will be issued. It is your decision how you satisfy the Entry Clearance Officer that your intentions are as you state in your application. It is your choice which documents you submit.

It is better to explain why you do not have a document than to submit a false document. Your application will be automatically refused and you may be banned from coming to the UK for 10 years if you use a false document, lie or withhold relevant information. You may also be banned if you have breached immigration laws in the UK.

All applicants

- A valid travel document or passport
- One passport sized colour photograph. This must not be more than 6 months old. (Please see photograph box below for full details)
- The appropriate fee
- If you are not a national of the country in which you are applying, evidence of your permission to be in that country e.g. a residence permit, visa, green card
- Evidence to support the information you have given (see below for more details)
- Previous passport(s)
- Evidence of how your trip is to be funded

Personal Details section

- Unless single, please provide evidence of your marital status e.g. marriage or civil partnership certificate, divorce certificate, death certificate
- You may be asked to present written notification from the child's parent or legal guardian that they consent to the child's visit (including evidence from your legal guardian to support their claim to be your legal guardian)
- The official record of any conviction(s), detailing the crime(s) you were convicted of and the sentence(s) you received

Finances and employment

- Evidence of your current employment/self employment/ occupation/work/studies/other means of support
- Evidence of your total monthly income from all sources of employment or occupation after tax
- Evidence of any income from other sources e.g. friends, family, savings, property etc

Student

- Evidence that you have been unconditionally accepted or enrolled on a course of study in the UK i.e. a letter from the school or university
- If you are applying as a prospective student, evidence of your contact with educational institutions in the UK
- Evidence of any previous study or qualifications gained in the UK or elsewhere
- Evidence of any English language ability or qualifications e.g. IELTS or TOEFL
- Evidence of previous education history
- Evidence of the cost of your course fees
- Evidence of all other costs relating to your studies in the UK, e.g. flights, accommodation, food, exam fees, books etc
- Evidence of any money paid out towards the cost of your studies, e.g. deposit towards your course fees, flights, accommodation
- Evidence that you can afford to finance your studies (if wholly or partially funding) e.g. bank statements
- Evidence of any funds set aside by your financial sponsors specifically to pay for your studies
- Evidence of your financial sponsor's occupation, income and any savings or assets they have
- Evidence that your sponsor has agreed to sponsor you e.g. letter from them
- Evidence of your sponsor's immigration status if in the UK e.g. copy of their bio data page from their passport (the page with their photograph) and their visa (if they have one) or other permission to be in the UK.

Your photograph must be:

- Colour
- Passport style and size (45mm high x 35mm wide)
- A recent and true likeness, showing full face, with no hat, helmet or sunglasses, although you can wear everyday glasses
- Original - that is not digitally or optically altered (for example it must not be 'photoshopped' or 'touched-up')
- Taken against an off-white, cream or light grey background so that your features are clearly distinguishable against the background
- Printed on low-gloss, plain-white photo-quality paper (with no watermarks or embossing)

Photographs that do not conform to these standards will be rejected and may cause a delay in processing your application.

8.10 Why have you chosen to study in the UK?

Please provide a brief description of why you have chosen to study in the UK.

8.11 Why did you choose this institution?

Please explain why you have chosen this particular institution to study at.

8.12 How did you find out about it?

Please give a brief description on how you found out about the course you intend to take.

8.13 Why did you select this course?

If this course is a change of direction from your previous qualifications or work experience or if it is at a lower level than your previous qualifications please explain here why you have chosen to do this.

8.14 Why do you think this course will be of benefit to you?

Please provide a brief description of the benefits this course will give you.

8.15 How many hours of organised study will you be required to attend each week? How much of this is during the day?

If you are on a recognised full time degree course or intend to follow a full time post-graduate course, please state 'Full time' in the box and give further details in Part 9 - Additional Information. Please state the total hours that you will study per week in the first box. In the second box please state how many of these hours are between 0900 - 1800hrs. Daytime study is defined as study between 09:00 - 18:00, Monday - Fridays only.

8.16 When this course of study is finished do you plan to undertake another course in the UK? Please give details of all further study you hope to complete.

Please include details of your full programme of study including all courses that you hope to complete, qualifications you expect to gain and names and addresses of the institutions where you hope to study (if appropriate).

8.17 What do you hope to do when you have finished all your studies in the UK?

Please provide details as requested.

8.18 Have you studied in the UK before?

8.20 Please provide full details of your education history from age 11.

Please give details of where you studied, dates of study and any qualifications obtained for your education from the age of 11 years onwards.

8.21 What have you been doing since you completed your most recent course of study?

Please provide details as requested e.g. working, unemployed, looking after family.

Financing your studies

8.22 Where will you stay in the UK?

Please provide full details

Give the name, full address and telephone number of where you will stay in the UK or if your accommodation is provided as part of your course, give the name, full address and telephone number of the accommodation officer at the institution you intend to study in, ensure to include the postal code with the address.

8.23 What is the total cost of the course?

Please provide details of the costs of all of the following:

- Travel to and from the UK
- Fees
- Accommodation (if included in the fees please state this)
- Living expenses (if meals are included in the fees please specify what meals and then tell us what other expenses you will incur)

Please state which currency e.g. US Dollars or UK Pounds Sterling.

8.24 Have any of these costs already been paid?

8.26 Who will pay for your travel to the UK?

If you are to be funded by a private individual(s), e.g. your parents, please tell us their name(s) and exact relationship(s) to you. If you are receiving funding from a corporate sponsor/charity please tell us this. Please supply us with full and current, independent and verifiable documentary evidence to support this

8.27 Who will pay for your expenses such as accommodation and food?

Please tell us who will pay for your expenses such as accommodation and food. If you are funding yourself please state this. If you are to be funded by a private individual(s), e.g. your parents, please tell us their name(s) and exact relationship(s) to you. If you are receiving funding from a corporate sponsor/charity please tell us this. Please supply us with full and current, independent and verifiable documentary evidence to support this.

8.28 Please provide details of your financial sponsor(s).

Answer Yes/No. If 'yes' please give details of their permission to be in the UK. Please provide supporting evidence of this by supplying a copy of their bio data page from their passport (the page with their photograph) and their visa (if they have one) or other permission to be in the UK.

8.32 What is your exact relationship to your financial sponsor?

Please provide details of your exact relationship to your sponsor(s), e.g. father/mother's sister/friend etc...

8.33 What is your financial sponsor's occupation or source of income?

Please give details as requested.

8.34 What is your financial sponsor's monthly income after tax?

Please state what your sponsor's monthly income is after deductions have been made after tax. Please state which currency e.g. US Dollars or UK Pounds Sterling.

8.35 Do they have any savings or other readily available money e.g. income from stocks and shares?

Please provide full and current, independent and verifiable documentary evidence to support this. This must be related to money that your financial sponsor has in his/her direct control and not from a business account for any company that they are involved with. Please state which currency e.g. US Dollars or UK Pounds Sterling.

8.36 How much money will they give you in total?

Please state how much money they will give you for your studies. Please state which currency e.g. US Dollars or UK Pounds Sterling.

If you have more than one financial sponsor please provide full details of each. If you require more space please use Part 9 – Additional Information.

8.37 What family does your financial sponsor have e.g. spouse, dependent children or other dependent relatives (parents, parent-in-law)?

This is only dependent family members i.e. those that live in the same household or rely on your financial sponsor for their support.

8.39 Has your financial sponsor sponsored anyone else wishing to enter or remain in the UK (including visa applicants) in the last 5 years?
